RECYCLABLE

Paper

- Newspaper, phone books, magazines and catalogs
- Direct mail advertisements
- Books, file folders and notebooks
- Paper of all colors, fax sheets, school papers, clean paper bags
- 4 Cs boxboard - cereal, cake, chip and cracker
- Corrugated cardboard (flatten, cut into pieces and place in cart)
- Boxes and cartons from multi-pack canned food and beverages

Cartons

- Milk and juice cartons
- Soup and wine

Glass

- Glass bottles and jars - three colors: brown, green and clear (remove lids and caps; rinse)

Plastic Bottles (*Leave caps on*)

- Milk, juice, soup, broth and wine cartons
- Plastic bottles (rinse)
- Plastic containers, margarine tubs, yogurt containers and medicine bottles

Metal Cans

- Metal food cans and aluminum beverage cans (rinse)

NOT RECYCLABLE

Paper

- Paper soiled with food, paper plates, paper napkins, pizza boxes, gift wrap

Glass

- Drinking glasses, ceramic dishes and vases
- Window glass and mirrors
- Light bulbs (take fluorescent and HID bulbs and CFLs to Household Hazardous Waste facility)

Plastic

- Plastic bags of any type
- Microwaveable food trays
- Motor oil bottles and other containers that held hazardous products
- Toys, plastic utensils and garden hoses

Metal

- Cans that held hazardous products such as paint thinner.
