

2014 Street and Utility Improvement Project Weekly Update



Current Events - Week of July 7, 2014 through July 11, 2014

- Trees that will be impacted by construction have been removed. The contractor is finishing removing the trees and stumps on West Road, West A/B/C, Fire Barn and East Road this week.
- Bituminous pavement and curb gutter removal on West Road continued this week. Driveway pavement will also be removed to the anticipated construction limits.
- Temporary water lines are being placed in the yards of the homes along the south leg of West Road. The temporary water line will connect to your outside hose spigot. A wye connection will be provided at your hose spigot for irrigation use.
- The contractor is installing dewatering equipment on the project this week. They have mobilized equipment and materials to the site and are preparing for the utility installation next week.

Future Events - Week of July 14, 2014 through July 18, 2014

- Temporary water line installation will continue for the homes along the south leg of West Road. It is anticipated that the temporary water system will be operational by the end of the week. The project inspector will be contacting you to turn off your water valve within your home and provide further instructions before the temporary water use begins at your home.
- The contractor will continue installing dewatering equipment. Once installed the dewatering equipment will run 24 hours a day to remove groundwater for sewer construction.
- The contractor will begin installing sanitary sewer on the south leg of West Road.

Please note: The tentative schedule provided is subject to change due to inclement weather or subcontractor availability.

Tips of the Week

- Please try to avoid hitting the temporary watermain hose with your lawn mower.
- If you have landscaping items close to the roadway, please remove the items you would like to keep. The landscaping items will otherwise be removed by the contractor.
- If you have an existing irrigation system, please remember to locate sprinkler heads and valve boxes with a distinguishable marker. If you have a pet fence, please have it located with a distinguishable marker. Please contact the project observer if you have any questions.
- Please use caution around construction equipment and materials. Follow the traffic control signs that are in place on the project.

- Please do not park on the street during construction. You will have access to the street and driveway unless otherwise noted. During the daytime, the contractor's equipment and stockpiled dirt will be taking up the entire width of the roadway. Portions of the street and your driveway may not be accessible.
