

2014 Street and Utility Improvement Project Weekly Update



Current Events - Week of August 4, 2014 through August 8, 2014

- The contractor continued installing sanitary sewer on the south segment of West Road working towards Lexington Avenue. The contractor also started the sanitary sewer service installation on this segment of road.

Future Events - Week of August 11, 2014 through August 15, 2014

- On Monday, August 11th, the contractor will have to turn off the water near Lexington and West Road as a part of their work. The homes on the north segment of West Road will be without water while the work is being completed. The project inspector will leave a water shut off notice with more details for the homes that will be affected. If you are currently on temporary water, your water will remain in service.
- The contractor will finish installing sanitary sewer on the south segment of West Road to Lexington Avenue. After the sanitary sewer and services are installed, the contractor will install watermain and services for this segment. Due to the depth of the utility installation, the road will not be passable in the area where they are currently working.
- The temporary mailboxes will be moved up to the intersection of Fire Barn and West Road. The contractor will provide another notice with more detail.
- The contractor will begin working on Fire Barn and East Road with removals of curb and gutter, bituminous pavement and driveways to the anticipated construction limits.
- The contractor will begin running the dewatering equipment for Fire Barn at East Road. The dewatering equipment will remain in place until they have installed the sanitary sewer. The equipment will run 24 hours a day to remove groundwater for the sanitary sewer construction.

Please note: The tentative schedule provided is subject to change due to inclement weather or subcontractor availability.

Tips of the Week

- Please try to avoid hitting the temporary watermain hose with your lawn mower.
- If you have landscaping items close to the roadway, please remove the items you would like to keep. The landscaping items will otherwise be removed by the contractor.
- If you have an existing irrigation system, please remember to locate sprinkler heads and valve boxes with a distinguishable marker. If you have a pet fence, please have it located with a distinguishable marker. Please contact the project observer if you have any questions.
- Please use caution around construction equipment and materials. Follow the traffic control signs that are in place on the project.

- Please do not park on the street during construction. You will have access to the street and driveway unless otherwise noted. During the daytime, the contractor's equipment and stockpiled dirt will be taking up the entire width of the roadway. Portions of the street and your driveway may not be accessible.
