

IRRIGATION PERMITS

Permits are required for all irrigation systems within the City of Circle Pines. Irrigation permits include a plan review of your proposed layout for zoning codes and inspections to assure compliance with all federal, state and local building codes. Permits are not designed to be a guarantee of the work but provide a reasonable degree of review and observation so that the project will be successful, safe and long lasting.

PERMIT FEES:

The fees for residential systems are a set fee for the irrigation and are based on valuation for plumbing the vacuum breaker. This helps cover the cost of the zoning review and the field inspections that will be conducted. Commercial fee is based on project value.

INFORMATION NECESSARY WHEN APPLYING FOR A PERMIT:

1. Completed and signed application for permit.
2. Site plan or survey detailing irrigation lines and sprinkler heads.
3. Copy of State Technology License **and** Power Limited Technicians License.
4. Copy of State Plumbers License and \$25,000 bond.

Remember, the purpose of the plan review and inspection is for the inspector to use his or her experience to inform you of potential problems or make suggestions. The more information shown on the plans, the more likely your project will be successful.
