

2012 Street and Utility Improvement Project Weekly Update



Current Events - Week of June 4, 2012 through June 8, 2012

- Trees that will be impacted by construction are being marked with a pink paint for removal. Most of you have already been contacted by the project observer, Jim Klein. If Jim was not able to contact you and if you have any questions regarding your tree(s), please contact him. The contractor will start removing trees on June 8 along Pine Drive.
- Temporary mailboxes will be installed at the intersection of East Road and Pine Drive, the exact location has yet to be determined. Mail delivery will begin at the temporary location on June 11. The contractor will remove your current mailbox and place it in your yard.
- Temporary water lines will be placed in the back yards of the homes along Pine Drive. The temporary water line will connect to you outside hose spigot. A wye connection will be provided at your hose spigot for irrigation use. The contractor will be contacting you to coordinate this work.

Future Events - Week of June 11, 2012 through June 15, 2012

- Bituminous pavement and curb gutter on Pine Drive will be removed on June 11 and 12. Driveway pavement will also be removed to the anticipated construction limits.
- Temporary water lines will continue to be installed and tested and it is anticipated that homes will be switched over to the temporary system this week or the week of June 18. The contractor will be contacting you to coordinate this work.
- Construction of the sanitary sewer main will begin mid-block on Pine Drive and continue to the south towards East Road.

Please note: The tentative schedule provided is subject to change due to inclement weather or subcontractor availability.

Tips of the Week

- Please try to not to hit the temporary watermain hose with your lawn mower.
- If you have landscaping items close to the roadway, please remove it if you would like to keep , it otherwise it will be removed and disposed of.
- If you have an existing irrigation system, please remember to locate sprinkler heads and valve boxes with a distinguishable marker. If you have a pet fence, please have it located with a distinguishable marker.
- Please use caution around construction equipment and materials.
- Please do not park on the street during construction. You will have access to the street and driveway unless otherwise noted.
