

2018 Street and Utility Improvement Project Weekly Update



Current Events – Week of April 30 through May 4

- Gas installation is proceeding along East Road heading toward Crossway Drive and Center Road.
- Top soil is being removed from the boulevards in **Phase 1** and continuing to **Phase 2**. The top soil is being stockpiled to be re-spread at the end of the project.

Future Events – Week of May 7 through May 11

- **Phase 1** will switch over to temporary water Monday-Wednesday. The contractor will assist each resident in turning on and off the correct valves in each house. Once the temporary water is on **DO NOT** open the main water valve to the house. The water will now come from the temporary water line that is in your back yard. The water coming from the street is now shut down for the rest of the project. **Please use caution when mowing near the temporary water lines.**
- Reclaiming of the road surface will begin on Monday in **Phase 1** and proceed to **Phase 2** (Crossway Dr and Center Rd) In **Phase 1** the material will be stockpiled until the project is near completion and will then be reused for road base. **Phase 2** the material will be left in place as a gravel surface until it is time for the sanitary sewer improvements.
- **Phase 1** mail service will be moved to the temporary mailboxes located by Inner Park near the hockey rink.
- Driveways are being removed starting with **Phase 1** and will continue to **Phase 2**.
- **Phase 1** sewer and water construction is anticipated to start on Thursday. Construction will start at Inner Dr (west leg) and East Rd and will proceed Northeast.

Please note: The tentative schedule provided is subject to change due to inclement weather or subcontractor availability.

Tips of the Week

- Please follow the signs and instructions on any notices that are distributed.
- Please use caution around construction equipment and materials. Follow the traffic control signs that are in place on the project and slow down when driving through the project area.
- Do not disturb the survey stakes.
