

# 2016 Street and Utility Improvement Project Weekly Update



## Current Events - Week of August 1, 2016 through August 5, 2016

- The sewer construction in **Phase 2** continues toward East Golden Lake Circle. Water main construction will start next Tuesday at East Golden Lake Circle and will proceed north.
- The concrete curb in most of **Phase 1** has been completed. The remaining gravel placement in **Phase 1** has begun. While the gravel contractor works on the **Phase 1** streets, be aware that there may be delays in getting traffic around that operation. The crew has been instructed to allow traffic to pass. It may take several minutes for them to be able to move out of the way. Use caution when traveling past the construction equipment and personnel.

## Future Events - Week of August 8, 2016 through August 12, 2016

- **WATER SHUT-OFF NOTICE** - On Tuesday, August 9, there will be water shut off for all of the residents north of 101 East Golden Lake Lane. This will occur between 8 a.m. and noon. When the water comes back on, residents should first open an outside faucet and or a laundry tub faucet for a couple of minutes to let any air and/or discoloration pass through.
- Gravel installation in the streets, and then the driveways, will continue on **Phase 1**. Concrete driveway apron construction and concrete driveway replacements will begin once the driveways have been graded and prepped with gravel. Once the concrete has been placed, allow 5 days for the concrete to be cured before driving on.
- As the progress of the utility crew working in **Phase 2** moves from north to south along East Golden Lake Road, be aware that the access for your house will be changing on a daily basis. If the crew is to the north of your driveway, please use the south access through the parking lot and trail to West Golden Lake Road. If the crew is working south of your driveway, please use the regular north access towards Golden Lake Road.
- **Restricted Access Note:** As schedules and conditions (work flow and weather) are variable, it is difficult to predict more than a day or so where restricted access to and from the residential driveways will occur each day. As the construction continues to move forward, the foreman of the crew will be knocking on doors inside the affected area in the mornings to alert the residents of the expected activities for that day. If you require a notice the evening before, please let Jim Klein know and that will be arranged.

**Please note: The tentative schedule provided is subject to change due to inclement weather or subcontractor availability.**

## Tips of the Week

- Please follow the signs and instructions on any notices that are distributed.
- Please use caution, watch for pedestrians and drive slowly on the temporary access road.
- Please use caution around construction equipment and materials. Follow the traffic control signs that are in place on the project.
- Please place your garbage can(s) at the curb line prior to 7:00 a.m. on Friday mornings in order to ensure pick-up.
