
Centennial Community Education Music on the Lake it's Golden Guests:

In preparation for your attendance at our Music on the Lake it's Golden event in collaboration with Centennial Community Education (CCE) and the City of Circle Pines, please note the following procedures created in response to federal and state guidelines related to offering activities during the Covid-19 pandemic:

General Guidelines:

- Follow social distancing guidelines of at least 6 feet whenever possible while within the park.
- CCE will be onsite during the event to assure a maximum of 250 in attendance is not exceeded per the current guidelines for outdoor events.

Performer/s Guidelines:

- Performers will maintain a barrier between themselves and the audience as they will not be wearing masks during the performance.
- Our performers are required to complete a [Health Screening Questionnaire](#) the day of the activity.

Participant Checklist:

- Please monitor how you feel prior to participation. If you are feeling ill, please stay home.
- Attendees will be asked to wear face coverings.
- Portable restrooms are available at the park and the restrooms in the concession building will be open during the event. These restrooms will be cleaned and disinfected before and after the event. Both restroom options are ADA compliant.
- The concession stand will not be open during the event. City staff are checking the park each day for cleanliness and emptying trash receptacles.
- Please bring your own water bottle with plenty of water - drinking fountains are not available.
- Participants need to practice social distancing during the event.
- We ask that you bring along your own chair for seating. The tables at the park have no assurance of cleanliness. The picnic tables available at the park will be placed at a minimum distance of 6 feet from one another.

If you have specific questions prior to your first session or at any point after that please communicate through the Community Education office and we will facilitate a response. Thank you in advance for your attention to these requests.
