



Welcome to the City of Circle Pines and Centennial Utilities



We would like to welcome you to the City of Circle Pines and to Centennial Utilities services. This letter and the folder of information will provide you with some basic information about the City of Circle Pines, Centennial Utilities and the community.

City Hall and Centennial Utility Offices: City Hall and Centennial Utilities offices are located at 200 Civic Heights Circle in Circle Pines and are open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Phone numbers and websites are listed below.

About Centennial Utilities: Deriving from the “cooperative lifestyle” of Circle Pines forefathers, Centennial Utilities was formed to provide the community with its own natural gas needs. Currently, Centennial Utilities serves customers in Circle Pines and parts of Lino Lakes and Blaine. Centennial Utilities has a Board of five Commissioners who meet monthly on the third Wednesday of the month at 5:00 p.m.

What services does Centennial Utilities provide for you? Centennial Utilities will be providing the services of natural gas, water, sewer, garbage and recycling. All of these services will be billed to you monthly on one bill. Bills are sent out on the 10th of the month and due on the 25th of each month.

Centennial Utilities currently has a remote meter reading program. Each Circle Pines property should have a recycling cart and refuse cart. If the size of the recycling or refuse cart does not suit your needs, just call and we can discuss other options.

At this time, monthly refuse rates are:

32 gallon-	\$ 9.48
64 gallon-	\$13.35
96 gallon-	\$18.66
Recycling charge-	\$3.54

An optional yard waste cart is also available for use during the composting season for an annual fee of \$85.00. Curbside disposal of bagged yard waste is \$3.00 per bag.

To remove extra garbage: a sticker must be purchased from City Hall, and placed on the extra bag of garbage. Cost of the sticker is \$1.00 plus tax. **Garbage is picked up every Friday and Recycling is picked up every other Friday.** Be sure to have carts at the curb by 6:00 a.m. Circle Pines has a single-sort recycling program. Please review the enclosed recycling information to find out when your recycling will be picked up and how the single-sort recycling works.

Note to Customers who own underground private gas lines: Customer-owned lines that are located after the gas meter and are underground running to an adjoining building or gas grill or other gas appliance, may be a hazard. These lines have a potential to corrode and result in a gas leak. Individuals with these underground lines are responsible for maintaining them. Steel lines need to be cathodically protected to avoid corrosion. Copper and other lines may also be subject to decay. It is extremely important that if you smell gas outdoors where these lines exist, you should call Centennial Utilities to investigate.
